Respondent	Serves/Files Respondent's record	Rule <u>310</u>	Within 20 days after service of Applicant's record
Any party	May seek leave to take additional steps	Rule <u>312</u>	After service of affidavits
Applicant	Serves/Files Requisition for hearing	Rule <u>314</u>	Form <u>314</u>
