NOTICE TO THE PARTIES AND THE PROFESSION

National Day for Truth and Reconciliation

September 8, 2021

Subsection 35(1) of the *Interpretation Act* (R.S.C., 1985, c. I-21) was recently amended to include National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, which is observed on September 30, as a holiday. Accordingly, by legislative reference, the day is also recognized as a holiday under the *Federal Courts Rules* (SOR/98-106).

Litigants are reminded to consider this legislative amendment in their computation of time. Any hearings previously scheduled for September 30 will be rescheduled.
